A Child is Born



Pope John Paul II in his address on Dec. 18, 2002 said, "The liturgy of Advent...helps us to understand fully the value and meaning of the mystery of Christmas. It is not just about commemorating the historical event, which occurred some 2,000 years ago in a little village of Judea. Instead, it is necessary to understand that the whole of our life must be an 'advent,' a vigilant awaiting of the final coming of Christ. To predispose our mind to welcome the Lord who, as we say in the Creed, one day will come to judge the living and the dead, we must learn to recognize him as present in the events of daily life. Therefore, Advent is, so to speak, an intense training that directs us decisively toward him who already came, who will come, and who comes continuously."

On Christmas day we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ. This is the day when God showed His love to this world by giving his only Son – Immanuel. No matter the suffering you might be in, don’t run away from it. You have to embrace it. Jesus was brought into this world to suffer for our iniquities. He never ran away from his suffering because he knew that His Father was, is and will be always be with Him. King Herod tried to kill Jesus as a small baby, but did he succeed? The same applies to us. Suffering may discourage us and destroy our faith if we don’t focus on the meaning of Christ’s coming into this world – ‘God with us’. Christmas is therefore there to remind us that God is with us. Whatever situation you might be in, perhaps it is the loss of a loved one, just know that it’s a matter of time. God is with us. God knows the plans he has for us. Through Christmas we are encouraged to continue believing for God is with us.

No weapon against him shall prosper. No-one or power can thwart His plans. **God is with us.**
